

CPR Certification

For College Students in Tennessee Schools

The Education Department of Belmont University has determined that all Education students in student teaching or internship placements in Tennessee schools must have a valid Adult/Child CPR Certificate **prior to application for Tennessee Teaching Licensure, Student Teaching or Internship**. Once this has been completed please bring to the Education department of Belmont University so a copy can be placed in your file. *Please note, this does not apply to observations, only Practicums that are required by some Education classes*

The following are instructions for obtaining your Adult/Child/Infant Certification through the American Heart Association:

1. Belmont University recommends The American Heart Association however **any valid Adult/Child/Infant Certificate will qualify**.
2. Go to <http://www.americanheart.org> Click "CPR & ECC" on the left hand side of page toolbar.
3. Click on "Find a class near you".
4. Then choose a course. Click on "Heartsaver CPR". A few locations are available to choose from.
5. Maps of locations are available by clicking on the "map" link next to the site you wish to attend.
6. Once you have completed the course, please send a copy of your certificate or issued card, to Andrea McClain: andrea.mcclain@belmont.edu

Class times and dates are available by contacting the telephone number listed next to the site you have chosen to attend in "Find a class near you". Registration and advance payment is required and can be completed by contacting the site number. The cost for the Adult/Child class is \$49.00 and the certificate is good for two years at which time it will need to be renewed.
